Final Details (V1 27/11)

Parking: will be in the Glen Finglas visitor car park to the north of the A821 (Callander to Loch Katrine road), c500m east of the village of Brig o' Turk. There is an overflow car park at Little Druim Wood (adjacent to the start / finish).

Assembly / Download: We are fortunate to have access to the Glen Finglas visitor centre. There is a (one) toilet within the visitor centre. Muddy shoes must be removed before accessing the centre.

Start/Finish: The starts and finish are both located c 500m from the assembly. The route will be marked / taped from the east side of the car park along a narrow gravel path. The clear, check and SIAC check will be located before the start – please ensure you have cleared and checked before you run. A punching start will be in operation, please leave 1min between fellow course competitors.

NOTE: competitors are required to cross the A821 on route too and returning from the finish. The road crossing will be unmanned. Please ensure you supervise any children and take care.

Terrain: The terrain is mainly rough but fast undulating open and forested hillside. The area can be very wet in December, please take care crossing marshes and all ditches. Longer courses (orange to blue) cross fences, please take care as there is barbed wire on all fences. Flagstone paths may be slippery, take care.

The area is bounded on the northern side by the A821 road and on the southern side by agricultural Loch Vennachar.

Map: 1:5,000, Contour interval 2.5m, mapped by Graham Gristwood in 2017.

Control Descriptions: These are printed on the front of the map. Loose descriptions will be available at the start.

Timing System: SPORTIdent will be used and touch free punching will be activated. All competitors are reminded that they must download before leaving the event, even if they have not completed the course.

Results: Will be available on the FVO webpage after the event.

Courses Close: 14:30. All participants MUST report to the finish by that time and please make sure you download.
